## OUR Top Ten TO DO in Victoria Falls

**1. See Victoria Falls** - its what you have come for! You need to allow a good couple of hours to walk the pathways and take in the spectacular views of the Zambezi River as it thunders over the precipice in a huge curtain of water that falls 110 metres (360 feet). *Visiting the Falls is included at Masuwe, entrance fees are additional and can be paid locally.*

**2. Game Drives** - there are 56,000 hectares of National Park surrounding the Zimbabwe side of Victoria Falls. Often seen species include elephant, giraffe, lion, kudu, eland and sable. Smaller, more secretive species such as leopard, jackal, hyena and bushbuck are there too. *Game drives are included at Masuwe, park entrance fees are additional and can be paid locally.*

**3. Sunset Dinner Cruises** - on an evening afloat on the Zambezi River spot beautiful birds, pods of hippo, herds of elephant and other animals as they come down to drink after a hot day; enjoy drinks and dinner as the sun sinks slowly into the River; the call of the Fish Eagle will forever remind you of the Zambezi. *A dinner cruise is included on a 3 night stay at Masuwe.*

**4. Flight of Angels** - David Livingstone wrote about the Falls; "a sight so wonderful that Angels must have gazed down on it in flight". Today you can take a helicopter flight over Victoria Falls and along the Zambezi River to return, spotting wildlife over the Zambezi National Park.

**5. Town Time** - at some point in your African travels you will want to browse the curio markets and galleries for a take-home memento or two and Victoria Falls has some great shopping options.

**6. Guided Walks** - Walk through the African bush with experienced rangers. It's as exhilarating as it is informative, and a great chance to discover the nuances and wonders of nature. *Guided walks are included in your stay at Masuwe.*

**7. Highwire & Bungee** - for the total adrenalin junky, Victoria Falls offers such thrills as bungee jumping, flying fox, foofie slide and gorge swing.

**8. Historic Bridge Tour** - built as part of the Cape to Cairo Railway in 1905 using revolutionary engineering methods this tour offers history, magnificent views and tests your tolerance for great heights!

**9. Village Tour** - The area is rich in culture and human history dating back over 700 years. Hosted by expert guides learn about daily life, history, cuisine and the traditions of the surrounding communities.

**10. River Adventures** - from canoeing the gently flowing Zambezi above the Falls, spotting wildlife in the National Park to the thrills of white water rafting, the Zambezi offers an adventure to suit your style.

Unless otherwise mentioned the activity is at extra cost. Transfers to/from tours, activities and for town-time are included in your stay at Masuwe.
